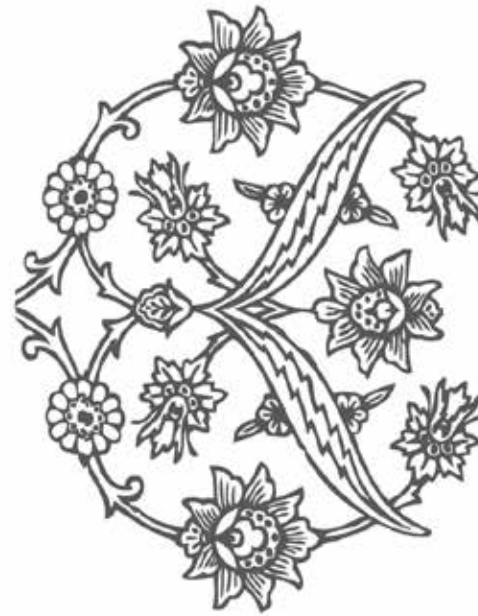

Forrest Lesch-Middelton makes custom handmade tile that graces homes, restaurants, kitchens, hotels, and businesses, internationally. Forrest has spent his career as an accomplished potter and educator with many accolades including the American Ceramics Society '2014 American Ceramic Artist of the Year'.

In 2013, Lesch-Middelton added a line of tile to his craft and Forrest has built a team that takes pride in every step of his unique tile making process. Each tile is made, fired, and packed by skillful hands in our Petaluma studio in the heart of Sonoma County, California. As each tile is made by hand, the final results yield beautiful variation, rich hues, and subtle textures that give new tile installations an immediate history in any setting. We value communication and craftsmanship above all else and would love to work with you to turn your vision into a reality.

TILE DETAILS

All tile is handmade, fired, and packed in our Petaluma, CA studio.

Available as individual patterns or as a variegated order.

Tile is durable and appropriate for use on walls, and light traffic floors.

Tile is heat resistant and great for fireplaces and wood stoves.

Tile is shipped to you unsealed. Without sealant it will patina and gain richness over time contributing to the overall aesthetic of your installation. If you prefer to keep your tile in it's original state we recommend using a sealer. We're happy to answer any questions you have about sealers and when they should be used to protect your tile.

Sealed tile is great for pools.

Your tile will be shipped with an installation and care guide.

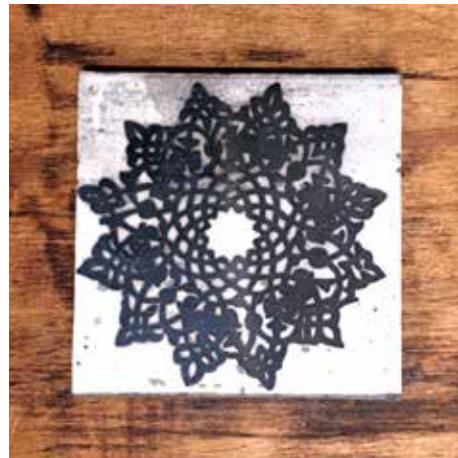




ORIGINS TILE LINE

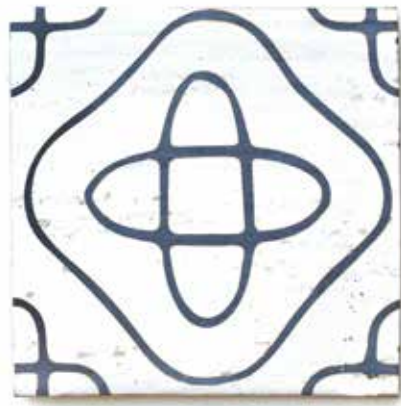


SOUND WAVE TILE LINE

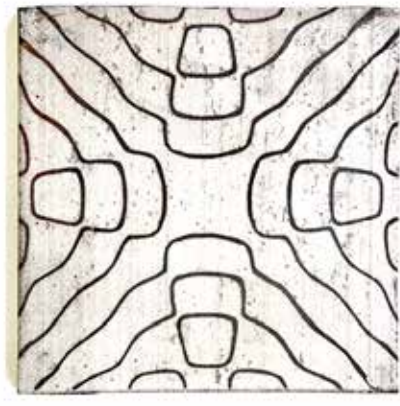
In 2017 I spent time experimenting with a Chladni plate, a metal plate balanced atop a tone generator that when dusted with sand, creates imagery through vibration. Particulate morphs smoothly, steadily changing into impeccable new line images. Pattern transforms into new pattern with the smallest shifts in frequency. The results are magical, beautiful, bold, and intriguing. Some equate it to music, some science, and some find the process purely mystical. This process is the perfect inspiration for our new Sound Wave Tile series. Each pattern is named for the unique frequency the Chladni plate was tuned to when the tile pattern appeared or the number assigned to the pattern by Ernst Chladni himself. Tile are available as individual patterns or as a variegated arrangement.



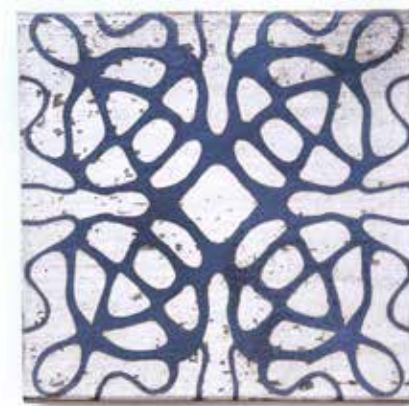
6" Pattern #1: Cast Iron
(1060 Hz)



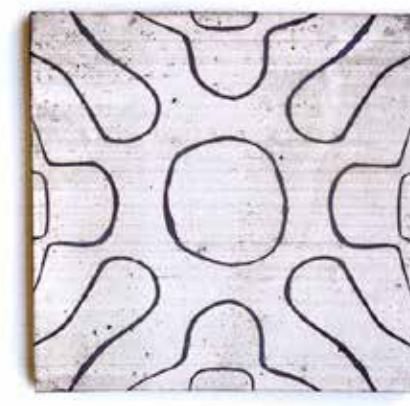
6" Pattern #2: Cast Iron

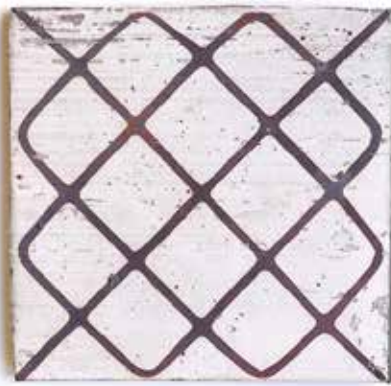

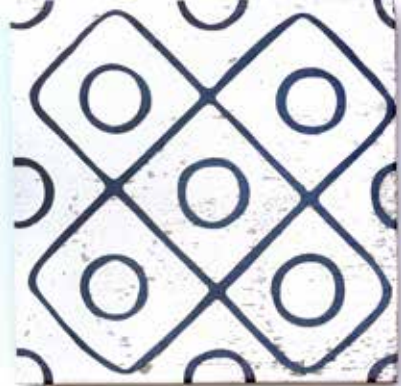

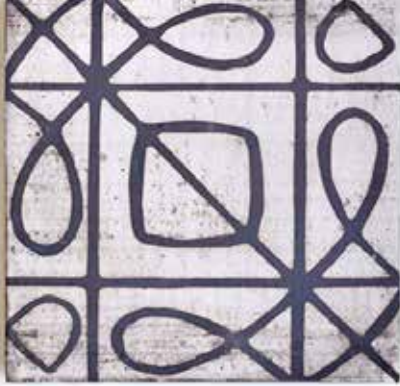

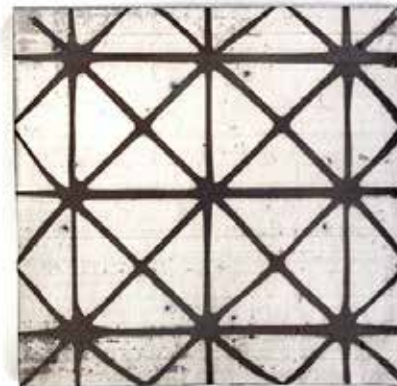

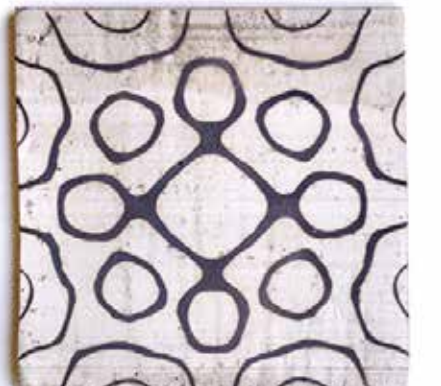
